Over three-fourths of us are on "Trees", and have found it to be an incredibly effective and safe way to make new friends.

The Loyola Group takes meetings into Hooper Detox Center twice a week. Men with at least one year of continuous sobriety are welcome to join us each Tuesday and Thursday at 1:30 to 2:30. Would those of you who already know they will be participating this week, please stand.
